TIRZ Redevelopment Authority Meeting

September 27, 2011

- 1. Kimberley Rd Project
 - a. Phase VI Step 2 and 3 all that remains
 - b. Target date for completion October 08, 2011
- 2. Regional Drainage Study
 - a. Interagency Coordination regarding Strey Lane Project
 - i. **Plan A** is "regional" plan involving a coordinated CIP program that includes COH, HCFCD, BHV, Hedwig Village, TIRZ17
 - ii. **Plan B** is made up of projects that the TIRZ can do on its own; essentially it would restrict its projects to only the geographical boundaries within the TIRZ. This would change the Barryknoll project as well as other future projects
 - iii. BHV currently plans to go the Plan B route and not allow the TIRZ to be involved in any Strey Ln work.
 - iv. TIRZ and LAN are currently discussing Plan A with BHV and they trying to get BHV to buy into Plan A
 - v. Points of consideration
 - 1. Plan B cost to BHV is \$6.0MM
 - 2. Plan A cost to BHV is \$3.8MM
 - 3. LAN states Plan A is better for all parties than Plan B
 - 4. I suspect the BHV engineers may say the exact opposite
 - 5. HCFCD supports Plan A
 - a. HCFCD must approve all plans involving discharge into W151
 - b. Remains to be seen if HCFCD would withhold approval on BHV going it alone
- 3. Barryknoll Project
 - a. Doing preliminary work that would happen either with Plan A or Plan B
 - b. Once a plan is determined will need to work on engineering that will be exclusive to Plan A or Plan B
 - c. Plan B would include additional drainage work on Bunker Hill (near Gaylord) to try to mitigate Hedwig Village drainage problems
