Regular meeting of the Fonn Villas Civic Association

The regular meeting of the Fonn Villas Civic Association was called to order at 7:25p.m. on December 5, 2011 at Pines Presbyterian Church by President Greg Holloway.

Present: Greg Holloway, John Baugher, Chuck Williams, Nick Hiemstra, Tonya Wright

Absent: Patrick Clynes, Nete Sundt, Ross Roberts

President Greg Holloway reports that a special meeting was held to discuss a replacement for position 3 formerly held by Christopher Heath. At this special meeting, John Baugher was unanimously voted to fill position 3.

The minutes of the November meeting were reviewed and approved. Motion made by John Baugher and seconded by Nick Hiemstra.

Oliver Aldrich gave the treasurer's report. (see attachment) He notes that the 1st deposit of maintenance fee collections for 2012 has been made. He also reports that the water bill was excessively high because of a leak at Bendwood Park that was previously reported. He is looking into getting a credit back from the city. Also noted was that the Fonn Villa Swim Club bank note has been paid off from Trustmark Bank. The civic association had first right of refusal on this note. The report was unanimously approved.

The Architectural Standards Committee report given by Dick Sundt stated that 1 application was approved. There was an inspection of the neighborhood on November 17, 2011. 33 letters were sent out to homeowners needing adjustments to their properties. The Architectural Standards Committee has been working on the final copy of the guidelines being revised due to legislative changes. There are a few more changes to be made but the final copy should be ready for approval by the February meeting.

The maintenance fund committee reports that the letters for 2012 funds have gone out to homeowners.

The parliamentarian had no report.

Advisory Committee Reports

The citizens on patrol committee had no report.

Diane Donovan reports from the directory committee on parking stickers. See attachment. The board will take this under advisement and report back at a later date.

No report from entrance beautification.

Ross Roberts for maintenance and parks had no report. It was noted during this time that the FVCA storage closet now requires a key and a code. Nete Sundt and Jack Long both have keys and code information.

David Tresch gave a detailed report from the last TIRZ 17 meeting. See attached report.

David Robinson had no report from the newsletter committee.

As previously noted, Patrick Clynes is now the head of this executive committee and will deliver his first report on the constable contract at the January meeting.

Dick Sundt reports for Nete Sundt that 1 new family has been welcomed to the neighborhood.

Webmaster Brandon Lackey had nothing new to report.

There was no report from the documentation committee.

The Memorial SN16 meeting was reported on by Tonya Wright. She stated some of the main points that are pertinent to the association. See attached report.

Old Business

No old business was discussed.

New Business

HOA e-mails/Website - The newsletter will have information about where to sign up to receive board e-mails about pertinent information, including future meetings. It will be a public website and will be a post only site. Residents will not be able to reply to e-mails. David Robinson will research cost and details regarding site. Nick Hiemstra made the motion. Chuck Williams seconded the motion. It was passed unanimously.

Security Contract – John Baugher made a motion to authorize President Greg Holloway to authorize and sign the new security contract from the constable's office. Nick Hiemstra seconded the motion. It was passed unanimously. The board will forward a signed executed copy to Treasurer Oliver Aldrich for the records.

New Executive Committee Proposal for Security – This committee will consist of Patrick Clynes, Ross Roberts and a third board member to be determined in January. This committee is an executive committee due to the use of FVCA funds. Tonya Wright made the motion. Nick Hiemstra seconded. It passed unanimously.

Record Retention and New Payment Plan Policy – On the advice of our attorney, we will approve 3 policies: Record Retention Policy, Payment Plan Policy and Records Reduction and Copying Policy. Nick Hiemstra made a motion to adopt all three policies.

John Baugher seconded. It passed unanimously. President Greg Holloway will handle signing, notarizing and filing.

Documents – The following documents will be filed of record at the County Courthouse and subsequently recorded on the FVCA website in order to comply with recent legislation passed: Procedures for the Architectural Standards Committee and the ACC, Procedures for Financial Management of the FVCA maintenance fund and the Maintenance Fund Timeline. Tonya Wright made the motion. Nick Hiemstra seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

President Holloway wishes to note that John Baugher is an exceptional parliamentarian and keeps us well informed.

Deed Restrictions - The property at Old Oaks and Memorial is still for sale. According to an attorney, the deed restrictions read that this property can only be used as a residential property or real estate office.

There being no further business before the board, a motion was made and seconded that the meeting be adjourned at 8:15.

November 29, 2011

- 1. Kimberley Rd Project
 - a. Just waiting on CPE to install street lights. No estimate of when this would be
- 2. W140 Detention Basin
 - a. LAN meeting with HCFCD in Dec
 - b. Project currently on schedule
 - c. Doing environmental study
 - i. Soil borings show arsenic and lead levels from old warehouse adjacent to the basin
 - ii. Don't know if there are significant levels to require large excavation and disposal of soil. Just as likely to be "background" levels detected and no special handling would be required
 - iii. FUGRO Consultants, Inc. will do further testing
- 3. RDS
 - a. Meet with COH, HCFCD and Hedwig Village 11/07/2011
 - b. Looking at other "regional" solutions without involving BHV
- 4. Barryknoll Project
 - a. See attached Presentation
 - b. Includes W151 channel improvements
 - c. Work at intersection of Barryknoll and Gessner will attempt to straighten out the curves east of the intersection
 - d. Sears and MetroNational will be approached to see if Barryknoll could be intersected with Kingsride at Gessner. This was discussed several years ago but received an adamant NO from Sears. Will see if Sear's feelings have changed.
 - e. Current timetable
 - i. Design: January 2012-August 2012
