Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Fonn Villas Civic Association

February 2012

I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular monthly meeting of the Fonn Villas Civic Association was held on February 6, 2012 at the Pines Presbyterian Church.

President Pat Clynes called the meeting of the Association to order at 7:19 pm.

II. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- All minutes are posted on the website.
- Minutes of December 2011 meeting. A motion was made by John Baugher to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Ross Roberts. The motion was unanimously approved.
- Minutes of January 16th organizational meeting. A motion was made by David Valerius to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Tonya Wright. The motion was unanimously approved.

III. TREASURER'S REPORT - OLLIE ALDRICH

- The Treasurer's report was submitted by Oliver Aldrich. (Report is attached.)
- The Annual income report and balance sheet were published in the February newsletter.
- Final report from 50th Anniversary dinner: 212 current residents attended, along with 47 past residents. The Special Events Fund contributed \$8,211 to the cost of the event.

IV. PARLIAMENTARIAN REPORT - JOHN BAUGHER

• John reported that a City of Houston planning and development form needs to be filled out by the President of the Board. That form was passed along to Pat Clynes.

V. ARCHITECTURAL STANDARDS COMMITTEE REPORT - DICK SUNDT

• Approved five (5) applications in January, including one new construction, one major remodel, and three minor changes.

VI. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORTS

- a. Maintenance Fund Will Frederking
 - 16 unpaid maintenance fund fees; letters are going out now. This number is slightly higher than last year.

- b. Security Pat Clynes
 - In January, we had a pretty bad report from the Constable patrol. While Fonn Villas was not hit hard, some neighborhoods around us had several incidents. We need to continue to be vigilant. Have you joined COP yet?
- c. Super Neighborhood Tonya Wright
 - The City of Houston has lifted the burn bans for the parks, and watering restrictions for yard.
 - On March 31st, there will be a "Trash Bash" to pick up trash along Buffalo Bayou in Terry Hershey park.
 - If any resident in Fonn Villas gets flooding in their home, they should report it to 311, so that the city can track flooding and deal with issues.

 - This past summer we lost of lot of shrubbery due to the drought and restrictions on watering.
 - We have a bid to replace shrubbery. This money is not budgeted, and would be in addition to the budget that was approved in December.
 - David Robertson made a motion to approve the proposal from Prewett & Associates for replacing plants at entrances. Tonya Wright seconded. The motion passed unanimously. A copy of the proposal is attached.
 - Bill and Ross Roberts are working to present a plan to the Board soon for maintaining the Attingham hedges.
- e. Maintenance and Parks delivered by Ross Roberts
 - Planning to clean light globes in March
 - Will be talking to the city about refreshing the mulch in the playground in Bendwood park.
 - Working (with Jack Long) to get the french drain fixed on the south side of Bendwood park; it's causing mud on the street.

 - No report, because David was unable to attend the meeting
- g. Newsletter report by David Robertson
 - Erik Nordt is doing a terrific job delivering the Fonn Villas News.

VIII. BUSINESS

- a. Election of new Director to fill unexpired term of Mike Moore (Tonya Wright)
 - Tonya Wright made a motion to appoint Greg Holloway to fill the unexpired term of Mike Moore. David Robertson seconded. The motion was approved unanimously.
- b. Update on status of recording FVCA documents (John Baugher)
 - We have had recorded six new guidelines: Roofing material, religious items, solar energy, rainwater collection, record retention, record production,
 - We have more materials ready to record: 1) Articles of Incorporation, 2) Architectural Controls committee Procedures, 3) Maintenance Fund Financial Procedures, 4) Maintenance Fund Timeline
 - Upcoming documents: Payment Plan, and Procedures to handle Minutes
 - The decision for tonight: Do we want to go ahead with recording, or wait?
 - Board sense: No, wait for another month so we can get Payment Plan and Procedures for Minutes
 - John Baugher will send Payment Plan info to the Board
 - David Robertson will send Procedures for Handling Minutes to Board before March meeting
- c. Discussion of signing 60/90 day letters to mortgage companies (John Baugher)
 - John discussed history of issue.
 - Pat has talked to the FVCA attorney, who is adamant that we not sign them.
 - A decision was made to conduct more research. Pat will talk to attorney and will report back to Board at another meeting.
- d. Discussion of new ACC guidelines (Dick Sundt)
 - Discussion of draft ACC guidelines.
 - Vote was not taken; discussion continues.
- e. Final review and approval of 2012 budget (Ollie Aldrich)
 - David Robertson moved to approve the 2012 Budget as passed in the December meeting, but with the addition of the \$1,950 entrance beautification contract approved earlier in the meeting. Will Frederking seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.
- f. Presentation and approval of 2012 Planning Calendar (John Baugher)
 - John Baugher made a motion to adopt the 2012 Planning Calendar (attached). David Valerius seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

- g. Discussion as to whether the Planning Calendar should be posted on the website and recorded along with all other "official" procedures per the new Texas legislative requirements. (John Baugher)
 - The lawyer says that it does not have to be posted, but the sense of the Board was that we should be as transparent as possible.
 - John Baugher moved that the Planning Calendar be posted to the website. David Valerius seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

VIII. ADJOURN

John Baugher made a motion to adjourn the meeting. David Robertson seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.
