Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Fonn Villas Civic Association

May 2012

I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular monthly meeting of the Fonn Villas Civic Association was held on May 7, 2012 at the Pines Presbyterian Church.

President Pat Clynes called the meeting of the Association to order at 7:20 pm.

II. REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF MINUTES

III. TREASURER'S REPORT - OLLIE ALDRICH

- Dick announced that he planned to print up 360 copies of the recently approved ACC guidelines, for distribution to all homeowners. After some discussion of the need to do this, when the guidelines can easily be found on the website (and printed as necessary), it was agreed that Dick would print only 20 copies, for distribution as needed.

 - Tonya called attention to the "Chapter 42 amendments", which are rules related to development. Apparently, in the past Fonn Villas has been designated as "suburban", subject to one set of rules. Going forward, Fonn Villas will be designated as "urban", with a different set of rules. HOAs were advised to check their deed restrictions against the new rules. Dick Sundt agreed to investigate this further.

 - Pat will check with the Constable to see whether he thinks they are valuable.
 - David Robertson will put an article in next month's newsletter, seeking input from residents.
- c. Donations for trees in park and at pool (Pat Clynes)
 - TIRZ 17 may be interested in investing in trees for Bendwood. Pat, Ross, and David Tresch will meet with representatives from TIRZ 17 to see what can be done.
 - Jack Long raised the issue of watering: It's easy to plant trees, but they need to watered if they are to stay alive and thrive in Bendwood park.
- d. Finding a new parliamentarian (John Baugher)
 - John will be stepping down as parliamentarian as soon as a replacement can be found, but certainly no later than end of this year.
 - The Board and residents are encouraged to think about people who might serve this role, so we can get someone in to work beside John and learn from him.
- e. Pool signage discussion (Pat Clynes / Jack Long)
 - The Swim Club (FVSC) is looking at upgrading signage at the pool. In particular, they are looking at a new sign on the Hallie side.
 - Jack Long has been working with the pool board, since he was involved in the Fonn Villas signage at neighborhood entrances.
 - The FVSC has not made any final decisions about signage, but Jack simply wanted to inform us, since it's possible that the FVSC will ask the FVCA to share in the costs of such signage.

David Robertson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Ross Roberts seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.
