- d. Memorial Super Neighborhood-Tonya Wright-Renee Ruiz, 832-393-0939 is direct line to ask about issues such as lights, doggie bags, etc. in park. Updates on burglaries from Constable and HPD about grandparent scams. Fire Chief Pena has new highwater vehicle. Proposition B is a 17-18% pay increase for firefighters based on San Antonio and Dallas comps. Active shooter presentation, THE GATE, available at Super Neighborhood Meeting Monday, June 24 from 6:30-8:00 p.m. Mayor Turner may be present.
